Sandy Springs Police Sgt Jeffrey Thomas and his Gang Unit will brief us on GANG ACTIVITY in our area. Sandy Springs Police Sgt Scott Levy and his H.E.A.T. Officer Head and Officer Vik will brief us on this special unit established by the Georgia Governor's office to address aggressive traffic (speed and drunk driving) — a leading cause of death and serious injury crashes on GA highways. For the first time in the history of highway safety the Governor has created a multi-jurisdictional task force, H.E.A.T. (Highway Enforcement of Aggressive Driving) designed to educate the public and enforce laws related to impaired and aggressive driving. Education and enforcement must go hand in hand if we are to be successful in reducing the number of crashes, fatalities and injuries on our highways. Although the information will be educational for all, it is highly recommended for new or young drivers.
